## What do college presidents find SO unacceptable?

- More time for feedback on student work and to prepare quality online courses
- Making sure every College has full-time librarians and in-house counsellors
- Getting faculty's consent before the College sells or reuses their course materials
- Ensuring contract faculty have better job stability and access to benefits
- Committees on equity, Indigenization, and workload that require the Colleges to actually implement change

You know what faculty find unacceptable? That the college presidents continue to put their profit agenda before students' education. Faculty have focused our demands on what students need NOW. This is not a fight about money; it's for a better college system. Faculty have been fighting for better because students deserve better and should expect more from their Colleges.

The college presidents refuse to negotiate, saying faculty demands are unacceptable and they will never agree to them.

# We know students are stressed.

That's why faculty have proposed to end this NOW by going to voluntary binding interest arbitration so that a neutral third party can settle an agreement based on what both sides have offered.

Sounds simple, right? But the Colleges won't agree to that either: they are trying to force an escalation, not find a resolution.
